

University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill Program Equipment Plan

The AV equipment purchased through the grant will be used in the future to train students studying audio preservation at UNC's School of Information and Library Science. We have sought new funding for continuing the Fellowship program for 2019-2020, and plan to move the AV equipment from UNC's Manning Hall to Wilson Library so that future Fellows are fully embedded into Wilson Library's AV preservation program, can benefit from training by library professionals and staff engaged in the work, and the equipment can be more easily serviced and maintained.
